To activate your Queen's NetID, visit <https://netid.queensu.ca/self-service/> (<https://netid.queensu.ca/self-service/>), click on Activate Your Net ID, and follow the instructions. If you receive an error, please wait the full 48 hours, allowing for your acceptance to be processed, before attempting activation again. You need your Queen's student number to go through these processes.

Following the processing of your acceptance and the activation of your NetID, email can be accessed via the main Queen's home page by selecting Office 365 from the SEARCH AND SIGN IN button located at the top right. Please access your Queen's email account and check it often to read information sent to you from Queen's.
